Thank you to Master of Ceremony, Martin Crutchley, and to Helen Dodd for co-ordinating the donations of raffle prizes.</p> <p>Special thanks to Gill Glass and Jeanette Crutchley for their huge role within the AFS. Gill was presented with a bouquet on Speech Day as thanks for her role as treasurer. Mike presented Jeanette with a bouquet within the AGM, thanking her for her role within the AFS.</p> <p>Developments within school this year include; SIMS, School Communications and Website updates.</p> <p>School fund, following a second appeal, is now over £2000, with nearly 50% of parents contributing.</p> <p>Funding for the school has been reduced and staffing is being adjusted accordingly. Improved and increased electronic communication with parents will also reduce expenditure. <p>Treasurer's report</p>	<p>2009 was a reasonable year for the AFS. Once all adjustments are made the accounts will show a profit of £2,511.</p> <p>The Dinner Dance made an adjusted profit of £924, the Quiz made £372 and house ties made £677.</p> <p>The New Parent's Social Evening funded the GCSE Presentation evening, leaving a profit of £63.</p> <p>The usual AFS donations were made for the Personal Accident and Community Risks Insurance. The AFS also made a donation towards the School Communications.</p> <p>The accounts contain approximately £3000, which will increase with 2010's fundraising events.</p> <p>Gill Glass thanked Edward Riley for auditing the AFS accounts.</p>
